



Orcas Island Farm to Cafeteria Coordinator

\$10,000 - 500 hours @ \$20 per hour, year-round.

Coordinator Qualifications:

Teacher Certification preferred but not mandatory
Farm/garden/food experience preferred

Responsibilities:

Oversee Garden Keeper and work closely with K-8 Farm to Classrooms so what the garden will facilitate what is being taught in the classroom. Make sure structures and facilities in the expanded garden are created and maintained and that the garden is maintained and managed properly.

Oversee Farm to Cafeteria budget and expenditures as well as uses, and increasing types and quantities of local foods available for school meals

Strengthen relationship with farms that supply to the school - encourage more growing for the school - especially in winter months

Increase/promote year-round use of school garden

Look for situations where the garden might be able to raise some money from items grown in the garden - possible sales at Farmers Market

Celebrity Chef events - find chefs and coordinate with classroom visit before lunch occurs
