Dear Mr. Sherman:

This letter is in response to your July 9, 2019, Notice of Intent to Sue (NOI) under Sections 7 and 9 of the Endangered Species Act (ESA) and its implementing regulations in which you allege that the U.S. Navy (Navy) and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) are in violation of the ESA (16 U.S.C. §§ 1531–1544). The alleged ESA violations are related to the Service's June 14, 2018 Biological Opinion issued to the Navy analyzing the effects of the *Naval Air Station Whidbey Island Complex EA-18G "Growler" Airfield Operations Project* on marbled murrelets.

The Navy and the Service have coordinated on this response to your NOI. The Navy has requested reinitiation of formal consultation on the *Naval Air Station Whidbey Island Complex EA-18G "Growler" Airfield Operations Project* in a letter sent to the Service dated August 20, 2019, (attached). The Service will complete formal consultation and issue a biological opinion on or about January 3, 2020, as described in the Service's reinitiation response letter of August 23, 2019, (attached). In the interim, the Navy will fully comply with Section 7(d) of the ESA, as explained in the Navy's August 20, 2019 letter.

We commit to providing you a copy of the 2020 biological opinion once it is finalized.
